La Puntion takes its name from the long and difficult harvest of a plot of old Carignan vines planted in 1945. Suave and harmonious, this cuvée reveals its generosity with round tannins and a delicious mouthfeel.

Dress : Brilliant garnet with purple reflections

Nose : Distinguished with peppery and kirsch notes

Aromas : Candied black fruits and light spices

Food and wine pairings : Charcuterie, tapas, Provençal dishes, grilled meats and vegetables
